

**Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding
Between
The Logan Education Association
And
The Logan Hocking Board of Education**

This Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is between the Logan-Hocking Board of Education (“Board”) and the Logan Education Association (“LEA”).

The Board and Association have entered into a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) which is effective from September 1, 2021, through August 31, 2024, and agree that a procedure must be developed in order for ARTICLE XV TERMS AND CONDITIONS, Section B, Class Size (I) to be implemented.

The parties agree that all procedures must comply with the Ohio Department of Education Standards for Serving Children with Disabilities in order to compensate members whose rosters exceed the operating standards per disability.

Furthermore, both parties agree to the following guidelines and revision of the negotiated agreement.

1. ARTICLE XV TERMS AND CONDITIONS, Section B. Class Size (I) will be revised to State: “Intervention Specialists will follow the Ohio Department of Education Operating Standards for Serving Children with Disabilities and will be reimbursed for caseloads that exceed said operating standards per disability category at the rate of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to write the Individualized Education Plan and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per student per quarter for progress monitoring”.
2. Those members exceeding caseloads will be reimbursed at the rate of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to write the Individualized Education Plan and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per student per quarter for progress monitoring.
3. Exceeding Caseload Forms must be completed and submitted by members as follows:
 - IEP Development and Meeting - At the completion of the IEP meeting
 - Progress Monitoring - The same date grades are due each grading period
4. Compensation for members who exceed caseloads will be retroactive and include the entire 2022-2023 school year.

The duly authorized representatives of LEA and the Board state that they have the authority to enter into this Agreement and MOU, which shall be effective upon the date last signed below.
